2. Who made you and loves you? Why did God make you? (NLJ 6)

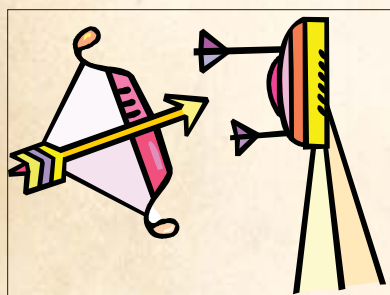
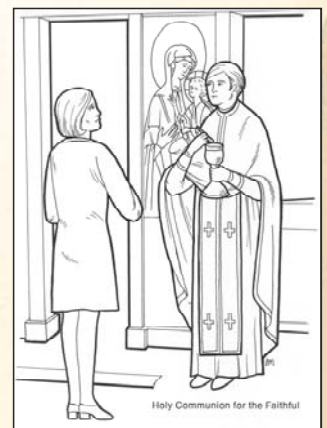
God made me and loves me. God made me to live united with Him now and forever.

I live united with God through being kind and helpful, praying, reading the Bible, and by receiving Holy Communion.

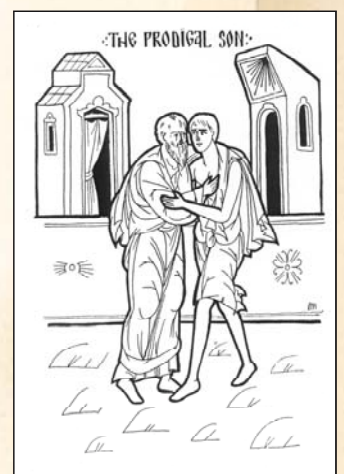


5. What does the word, "sin," mean? (MTR 6) How do you "sin?"

6. What do we do when we've sinned? (MTR 10)

5. What happens in the Mystery of Confession? (MTR 10)

In the Mystery of Confession, we explain how we "missed the mark," or sinned. God forgives us when the priest places the epitrachelion on our shoulders. We are made new again, like in baptism.
